It is our pleasure to let you know that the <u>U.S. is lifting</u> the vaccination requirement for international travelers entering the U.S. The United States will end all pandemic travel requirements at the end of the day May 11. Starting May 12, international travelers coming into the USA, whether by air, land, or sea, will no longer have to present proof of vaccination against the coronavirus.

This should make it much easier for you to sell the United States and therefore grow your business. This decision was made by the Centers for Disease Control in coordination with the Department of Homeland Security.
